## The University of British Columbia ("UBC") Policy on Science Education Initiative at UBC

On January 1, 2007, Dr. Carl Wieman joined UBC to enhance the educational experience of undergraduate students through the Carl Wieman Science Education Initiative ("CWSEI").

This Policy applies to all UBC faculty, students, post-doctoral fellows and employees (the UBC Participants") who wish to collaborate with Dr. Carl Wieman in the development of educational materials and tools to facilitate the teaching of science at UBC.

The purpose of this Policy is to set out and confirm for the UBC Participants how the materials developed in CWSEI will be managed:

- The objective of CWSEI is to create educational materials and simulations to enhance the education of undergraduate students and to make these materials, including any software, publicly available at minimum costs to promote their availability and use.
- UBC Participants who wish to participate in and contribute to CWSEI retain all copyright in the materials they create for CWSEI, and waive all moral rights in those materials in favour of UBC. UBC will have a non-exclusive, royalty-free, perpetual and irrevocable license to use CWSEI materials for any purposes. UBC will own all copyright in any compilation of CWSEI materials.
- 3. UBC and the University of Colorado at Boulder have agreed that materials will be freely shared between the two institutions in the education of undergraduate students.
- 4. CWSEI will have the primary responsibility for distributing and making CWSEI materials publicly available at minimum costs, primarily through posting on the Internet and use of GNU General Public License.
- In the event that UBC receives a request for a commercial license for CWSEI materials, UBC's University-Industry Liaison Office will negotiate with the third party for a license to use CWSEI materials on commercially reasonably terms.
- 6. Any revenue (net of the third party expenses) received by UBC for such commercial license will be returned to CWSEI to support ongoing development of CWSEI materials. UBC Participants and contributors to CWSEI will not participate in any such revenue.
